

Our Learning

We would like to share just a few of the objectives that we will be working on this half term in the Prime areas of learning. These are things that your child can practice at home.

Communication and Language

Enjoy listening to longer stories and can remember much of what happens. Use longer sentences of four to six words. Be able to express a point of vies and to debate when they disagree with an adult or friend, using words as well as actions.

Personal Social and Emotional Development

Increasingly follow rules, understanding why they are important. Do not always need an adult to remind them of a rule.

Physical Development

Use a comfortable grip with good control when holding pens and pencils. Be increasingly independent as they get dressed and undressed, for example putting coats on and doing up zips.
