<u>History</u>

Vikings and Anglo Saxons

This term, Year 6 will be exploring a topic called Traders and Raiders and answering the question, 'Why was England an attractive target for the Vikings?'

Our aims will be to be able to describe Britain's settlement by Anglo-Saxons and Scots and to describe the Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the Kingdom of England to the time of Edward the Confessor. Photographs of our Virtual Viking workshop will be shared soon!

Reading

Reading is a priority at Hunslet Moor and we encourage children to read as regularly as possible as this supports them with the wider curriculum.

Please try to listen to your child read as often as possible and encourage your child to read every evening for at least 15 minutes.

If you have any books that belong to school, please support us by bringing them in.

This year, we will continue to record reading at home on Class Dojo. A meeting to welcome parents and share key messages will be on the 10th September at 2:45pm in the main hall. Year 6's first visit to Dewsbury Road Library is on the 24th of September 2024.

Maths

We will be focusing on Place Value and reinforcing children's understanding of number throughout the Autumn term. We will be exploring the formal methods of addition and subtraction, multiplication and division by the end of the term.
