### **Learning in Nursery**

Again we have planned lots of exciting activities to extend and develop your child's learning in all areas of the curriculum (See curriculum plan on School web site). A spare clothes bag.



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# **Apply for a primary school**

If your child was born between 1 September 2020 and 31 August 2021 they should start primary school in September 2025. You will need to make an application for a place at a primary school.

## **How to apply**

You can apply from 1<sup>st</sup> November 2024. The deadline to apply is 15<sup>th</sup> January 2025.

### When you'll find out

You will be offered a primary school place on 16<sup>th</sup> April 2024. If you applied on line you will receive an email. If you applied in any other way, you will receive an offer letter to your registered home address a few days after the 16<sup>th</sup> April.
