## <u>History</u>

## Vikings and Anglo Saxons

This term, Year 6 will be continuing to explore our topic called Traders and Raiders and answering the question, 'How did the Vikings and Anglo Saxons influence our country?'

Our aims will be to be able to describe Britain's settlement by Anglo-Saxons and Scots and to describe the Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the Kingdom of England to the time of Edward the Confessor.

## Reading

Reading is a priority at Hunslet Moor and we encourage children to read as regularly as possible as this supports them with the wider curriculum.

Please try to listen to your child read as often as possible and encourage your child to read every evening for at least 15 minutes.

If you have any books that belong to school, please support us by bringing them in.

We record reading at home on Class Dojo.

Please do this at least a couple of times a week.

We are looking forward to our visit to Dewsbury Library on 12th November 2024.

#### Maths

We will be focusing on Fractions, whilst continuing to reinforce children's understanding of number from Autumn 1. We will be exploring adding and subtracting proper fractions, improper fractions and mixed numbers, comparing and simplifying fractions as well as multiplying and dividing fractions by fractions and whole numbers.
