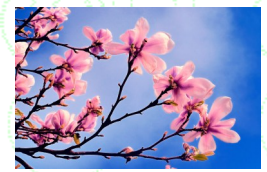




Spring - Year 1



Topic—Everybody's Playing

This term, Year 1 will be learning all about the history of communication and toys within living memory. We will learn about how the invention and improvements in computers and telephones have changed the way we play and learn. Children will look at technology over the last

Reading

Reading is a priority at Hunslet Moor and we encourage children to read as regularly as possible.

Always write a comment in their reading journal to show their teacher they have read at home. Maths

In Maths, we will be focusing on place value within 20, before moving on to addition and subtraction to 20, using whole—part models, number lines and counting. We will be moving onto place value within 50, partitioning numbers into tens and ones, finding one more and one less and comparing numbers using greater than, less than and equals to.

Towards the end of the term, we will be learning about length and height and volume and weight.

Homework

Please support your child by completing their homework which will be sent out on Wednesday each week. This is phonics based to support your child.

PE

In Year 1 this term, we will be teaching the children dance skills (indoor) and running, jumping and throwing (outdoor).

Please wear the school PE kit you were provided with last year into school on the correct PE day.

This half term, we will be learning about the topic 'Polar Places'.
