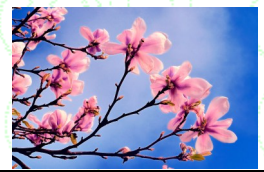


Spring - Year 2

We will learn about the history of nursing Florence Nightingale, Edith Cavell Nellie Spindler.

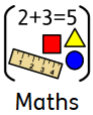


Reading is a priority at Hunslet Moor and we encourage children to read as regularly as possible.
