Reading



Reading is a priority at Hunslet Moor and we encourage children to read as regularly as possible as this supports them with the wider curriculum.

Please try to listen to your child read as often as possible and encourage your child to read every evening for *at least 15 minutes*. Always post on Dojo so we can help monitor and see all the fantastic reading they are doing.

Writing



This term, we will be focusing on writing a range of genres such as character descriptions, reports and finally a performance poetry which all links to our stone age topic.

Maths



We will be focusing on Multiplication and division as well as diving into length and perimeter. Later on in the term we will be looking at fractions and decimals and also reinforcing the children's understanding of number throughout the spring term.

It is important that children know their times tables up to 12x12, to prepare them for their Multiplication Tables Check in the Summer term. Please ensure that your child is regularly practising their times tables at home.

Topic

This term in History, we will journey back in time to the **Stone Age, Bronze Age, and Iron Age**. We'll explore how early humans lived, from scavenging and hunting to farming and settling in villages. Through their tools, homes, and discoveries, we'll uncover how these periods shaped the foundations of our modern world.
