## Geography

Extreme Earth: Japan

This term, Year 6 will be starting their geography topic, Extreme Earth: Japan. We will be answering the question: 'What is it like to live in a seismic country?'

Our aims will be to use a world map to locate Japan, as well as the surrounding seas and oceans; understand the causes of earthquakes, tsunamis and volcanoes and the impact these have on Japan and to explore the physical geography of Japan, comparing it to the UK.

Reading
Reading is a priority at Hunslet Moor and we encourage children to read as regularly as possible as this supports them with the wid-

er curriculum.

This year, we will continue to record our reading at home on Class Dojo. Please get in touch if you have trouble accessing Class Dojo in any way. It has been great to see so many of our children reading at home and posting on class Dojo. We would kindly ask that you continue to support your child in remembering to complete this.

Year 6's next visit to Dewsbury Road Library is the 14th January 2025.

<u>Maths</u>

This term we will be focusing on ratio and algebra, whilst continuing to reinforce children's understanding of number through weekly arithmetic tests. We will be exploring the relationship between ratio and fractions, using scale factors and solving a wide range of reasoning questions.

It is important that children know their times tables up to 12x12, along with corresponding division facts.
