Topic - Dinosaurs

Reading

Maths

We will be focusing on measurement and geometry
The children will be looking at understanding heavy
and light objects and comparing different lengths. We
will also be continuing to reinforce counting with
some children counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.

This half term we will be learning about families and our differences within different families and cultures. We will also learn about important places and objects within different cultures.
