5&6	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• pull together clues from action, dialogue and description to infer meaning• discuss moods, feelings and attitudes using inference• draw information from different parts to infer meaning• justify inference using reference to the text• discuss moods, feelings and attitudes using inference• use PPE (point, evidence, explain) to support inferences• identify and comment on explicit and implicit points of view
