96% - 100% - Excellent Attendance
Good attendance gives you the best chance to succeed

90% - 95% - Attendance causing concern.
Poor attendance gives you less chance to achieve their potential. Attendance Provision Plan to be put in place.

Below 90% - Attendance is being monitored.
Very poor attendance has a serious impact on your child's learning. Your child may struggle to achieve their targets and exam results. Possible FINE or PROSECUTION.
