




## Knowledge

- A **habitat** is a home for plants and animals.
- Animals are living things that breathe and move around on their own.
- A **carnivore** eats other animals, e.g. a lion. 
- A **herbivore** eats plants, e.g. a rabbit. 
- A **omnivore** eats both animals and plants, e.g. a human.
