- Japan is a country in Asia.
- It is in the Northern Hemisphere.
- The capital city of Japan is Tokyo, which has a population of over 37 million.
- Invisible lines of latitude and longitude form a grid over the earth.
- The crust of the earth is made up of tectonic plates. The plates are always moving.
- The edges of the plates are called faults, which can rub together and cause earthquakes, volcanic eruptions and even tsunamis!
