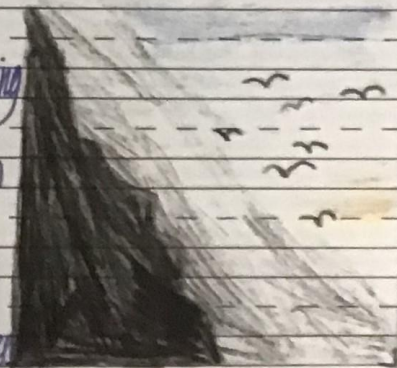

The Pyrenees mountain is the border between France and Spain. When you are on the road on the mountain it goes in a spiral. Spain and

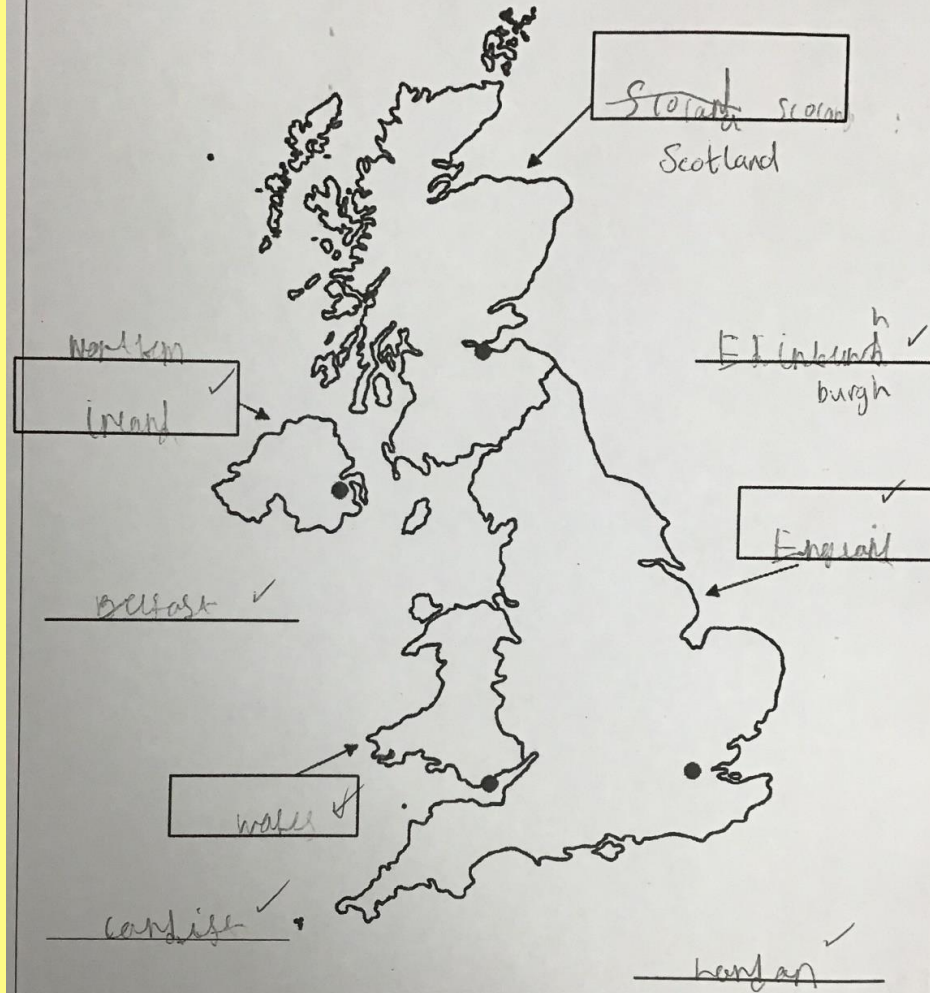
France are about 430m apart from each other. This mountain is very popular for hiking and skiing. On the west side of the mountain it is colder and the east side is warmer.

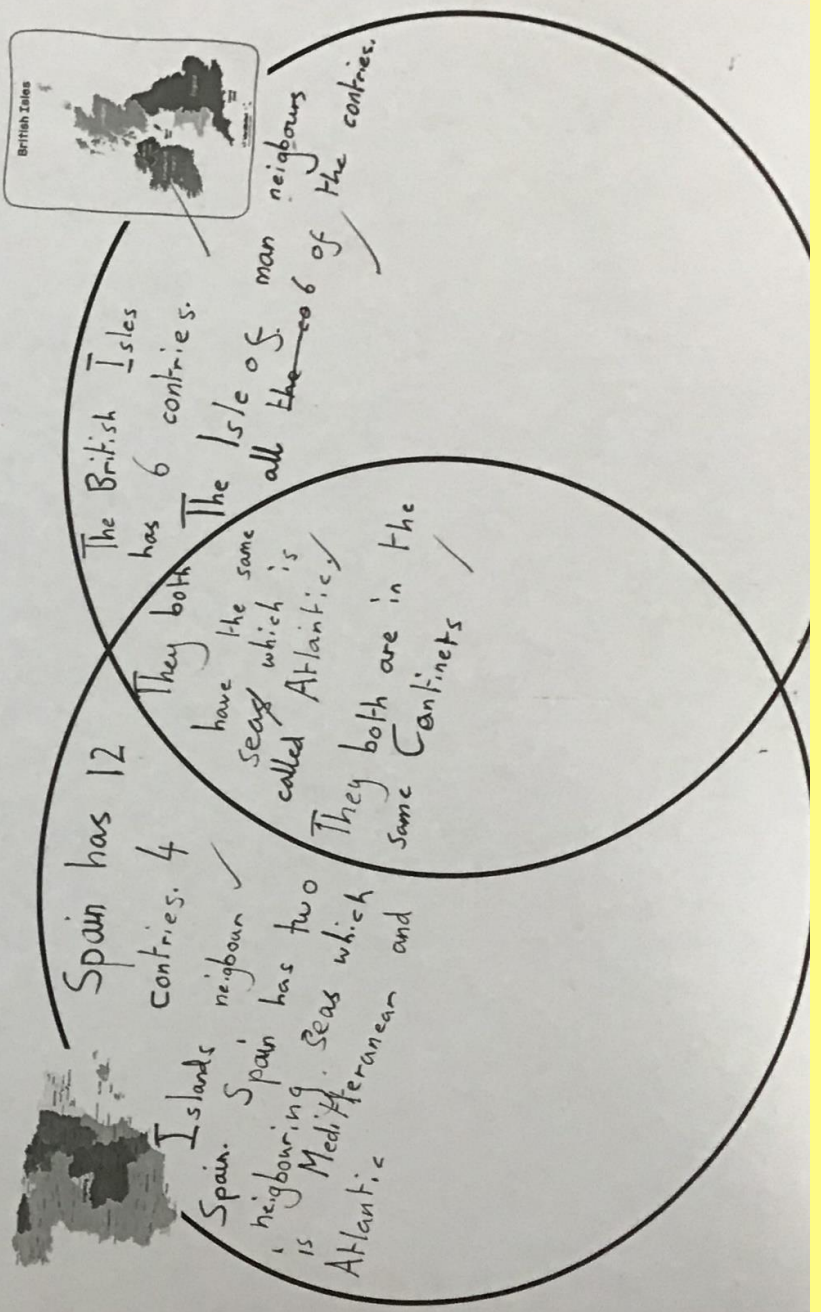
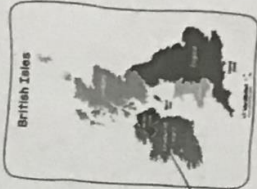
