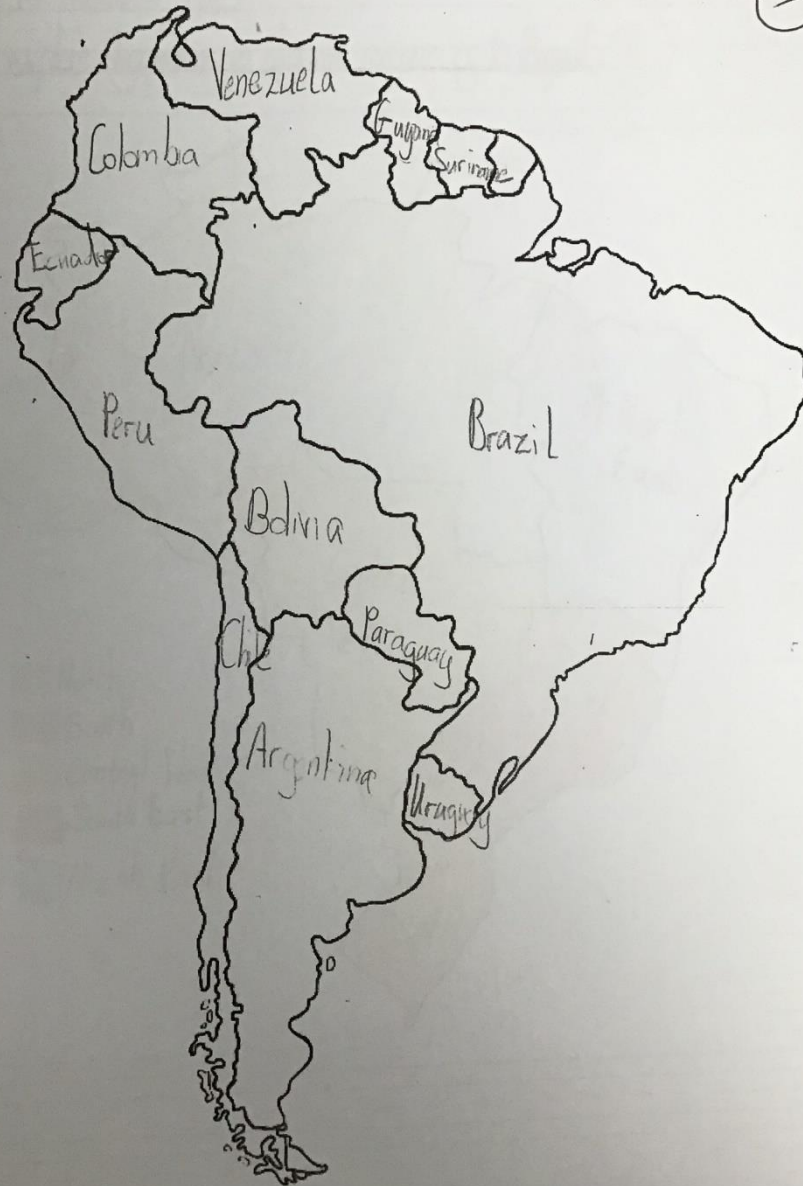


We started our topic with a Brazil day where we made festival masks and learnt to samba!

Central West



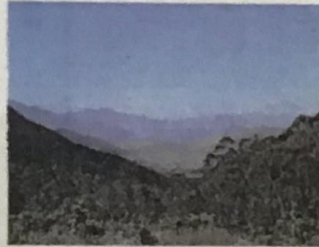
The climate is hot and tropical. Lots of tourists go to the Central west.
